

**Elk Meadow**, in Evergreen. 9:30-10:00am. Weather report as of Thur.13th - Sun. is 77 degrees, partly cloudy, 10% chance of rain. Trail surface is dirt with some rocky spots as you climb. Shoes recommended. BBSC will be riding the lower loop (open & grassy climbing up to wooded) is rated "Easy" to "Moderate". (Note - the upper loop which is wooded, is rated "Difficult" for the sharp climb and many switchbacks.) Restroom at trail head. Bring your own drinking water for horse and rider. Shared users are hikers, dogs on leash law, occasional mountain bikers.

**Directions:** From Denver, take I-70 west to exit # 252 / Evergreen Pkwy / Hwy 74, go south / left for approx. 4 miles. Will see the park as you pass it, on the right / west side. Take Lewis Ridge Rd, go west / right (under the wooden "arch") for about 1/8th mile, to the gravel parking lot on the north / right side. Trailers are able to park on the upper west section of the parking lot. Space for approx. 4 trailers. I-70 is a bit of a grade for hauling a trailer
