

Indian Creek

This is a very popular camp'n'ride spot! Rated "moderate", water crossings, approx 70% of the trail is rocky, with drop offs, switchbacks & steep elevation gain. An all day ride. Tends to be a cool ride, when it's hot everywhere else. John will bring a 200 gallon water tank. Byo tent/RV & horse panels/high line, etc. \$4/day parking, \$14/night campsites, 4 horses per site, 7 campsites. One vehicle may park at each site, additional vehicles must park in the overflow lot nearby.

Directions – From Denver, take I-25 south. At exit # 187 (Happy Canyon Rd) go right/south for 2.5 miles. At US-85, go right/west for 3 miles – to the little town of Sedalia. In town, take CR-67 going west/right for slightly over 10 miles. The Indian Creek Campground parking lot is on the north/right side of the road. Be sure your hauling vehicle is able to handle mountain roads!
